PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

The goal of these workshops is to receive comments to ensure conduct of a thorough and balanced alternatives analysis in response to comments raised during the California Coastal Commission (CCC) appeals process through facilitating public agency input, and responsiveness to comments and concerns during the proposed site screening process.

The workshops will include discussion opportunities and a public comment period for general topics related to the Water Treatment Plant Alternatives Analysis, including, but not limited to: site identification and selection; evaluation criteria; CCC appeals process and Local Coastal Program policy consistency; environmental site constraints and impacts; and water reclamation feasibility.

This is a Public Workshop which may include quorums of the Board of Directors for the Cayucos Sanitary District and of the City Council of Morro Bay and of the following City of Morro Bay Advisory Bodies: Planning Commission, Harbor Commission, Public Works Advisory Board, Harbor Advisory Board, Parks and Recreation and Parks Commission, Community Promotions Committee, Tourism Business Improvement District and Citizen Oversight Committee. No formal action will be taken by the Council, Board, and/or the Advisory Bodies as a group.
