**TORO CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PIPELINE  
IMPROVEMENTS: PACKAGE 1 TEMPORARY BYPASS**

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Toro Creek Bridge Replacement Pipeline Improvements will be received by the Cayucos Sanitary District at the office of the Cayucos Sanitary District until 11:00 am local time on **May 12<sup>th</sup>** ~~April 6<sup>th</sup>~~ 2021, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of construction of a bridge for temporary pipeline crossings of Toro Creek. The work generally includes: design of a temporary or semipermanent bridge and abutments; mobilization; site preparation; grading/earthwork; installation and maintenance of storm water BMP's, furnishing materials for project; submittal and document preparation; compliance with regulatory requirements; coordination with biological/archeological monitors; Site maintenance, safety, and security; surveying; temporary facilities, hydro testing completed work and all other construction efforts required to install all infrastructure described by the plans. The Engineer's cost estimate for the Project is \$1,350,000.

Bids will be received for a single prime contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis with bid items as indicated on the Bid Form.

Prospective bidders may call to make arrangements to examine the Bidding Documents at the locations identified below. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall submit proof of qualifications to perform the Work as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

Prospective Bidders shall be licensed Contractors in the State of California and shall be skilled and regularly engaged in the general class or type of work called for under the Contract. Each Bidder shall have a Class A California Contractor's license.

American Iron and Steel Requirements apply to this project as described in the Buy American law (23 U.S.C., Section 313) and applicable regulations, including 23 CFR §635.410 and FHWA guidance. mandating domestic preference. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron and steel: line or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver applies to this contract.
